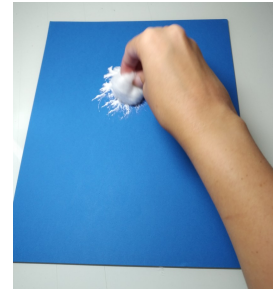
Cloud Creations



Are you inspired by the Adventures for Your Senses activity that asks you to draw, take photos, record, or write a poem about clouds? Try making your own cloud creations using ingredients commonly found around the house!

Supplies

- 3/4 cup shaving cream
- 1/4 cup white glue
- bowl
- spoon
- blue paper
- cotton balls, rounds, and/or swabs



Instructions

1. Measure out the shaving cream and glue. Put them into a bowl and mix with a spoon.
2. Put a sheet of blue paper on your work surface.
3. Dip a cotton ball into the mixture and apply it to the paper to form cloud shapes. You can also use a cotton round, a cotton swab, or your fingers.
4. Continue dipping and applying until your picture is complete.
5. Allow your cloud creation to completely dry. Touch it to feel the interesting texture.
